


# Gazebo kit in HO scale



Base and, figures, benches, and cars not included

This kit includes all parts, laser cut in micro-plywood and self adhesive shingles. All parts fit together but may need light sanding in joints for cosmetic reasons. The model needs painting.

Some model building and painting skills are required.

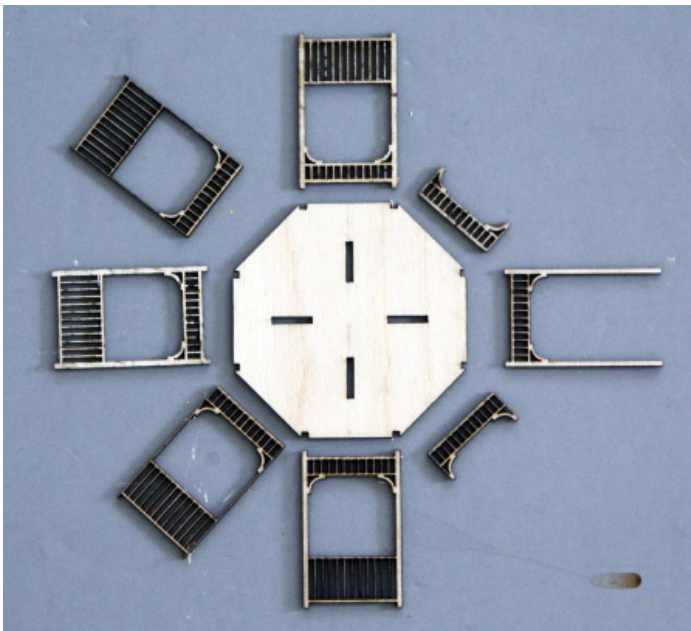
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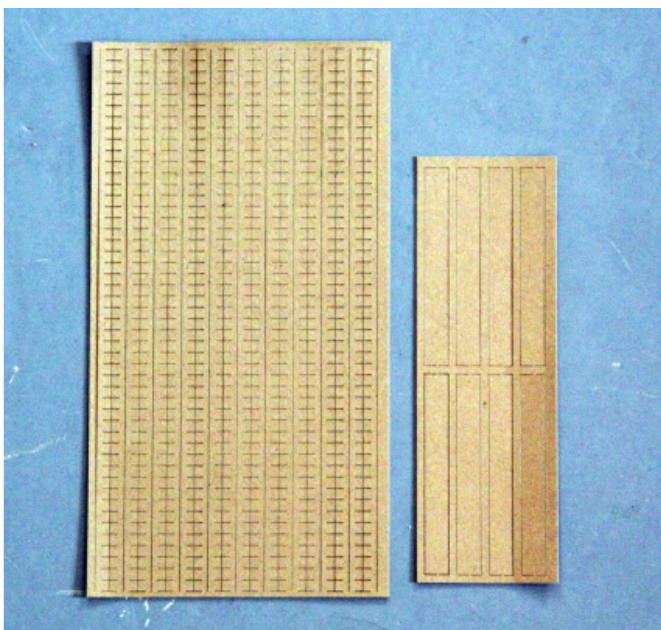
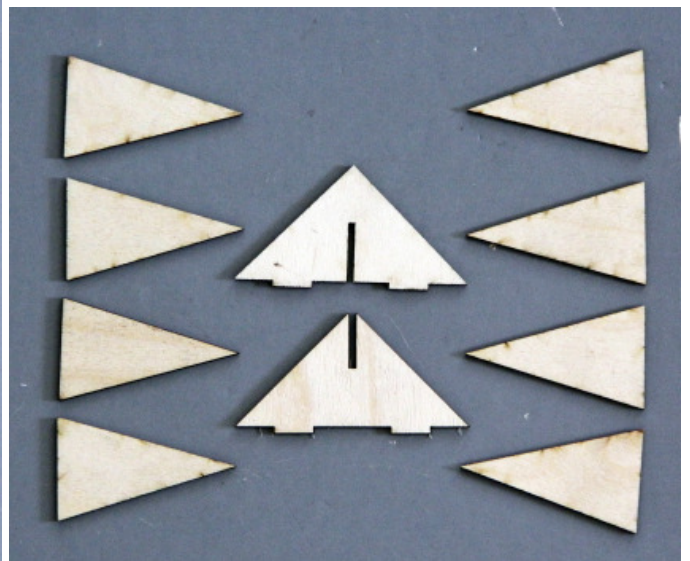
## Assembly instructions for Gazebo

Thank you for buying this Gazebo kit. Please take some time to read these instructions before you begin assembling.

This kit is laser cut in micro-plywood and is very easy to glue together using CA glue. Take your time to identify all parts, lay them out and clean them for any burrs before gluing them together.



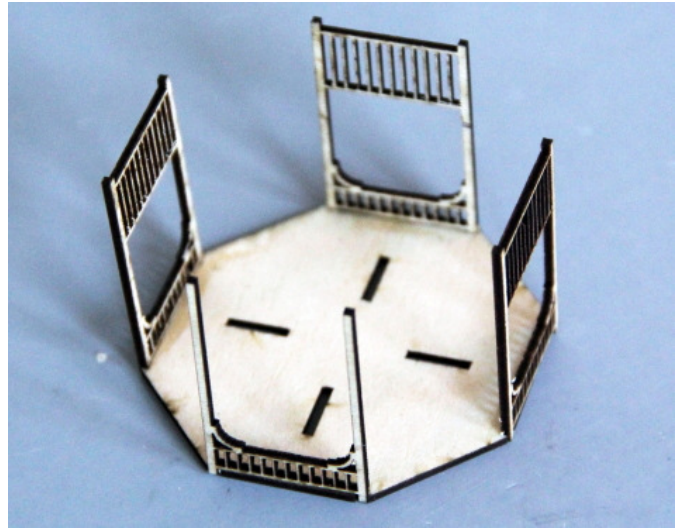
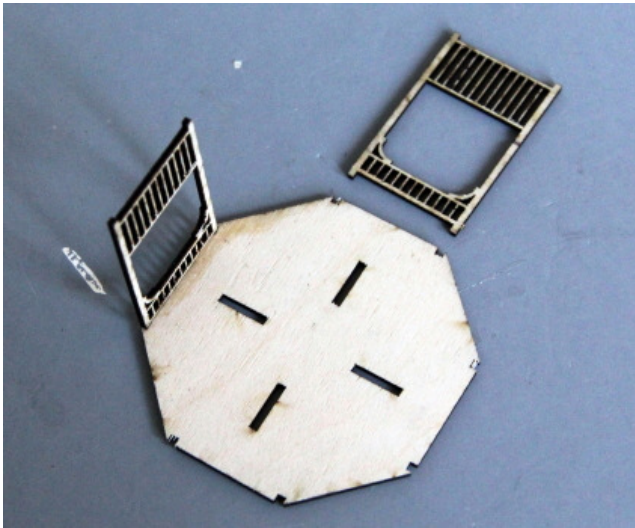
Parts overview



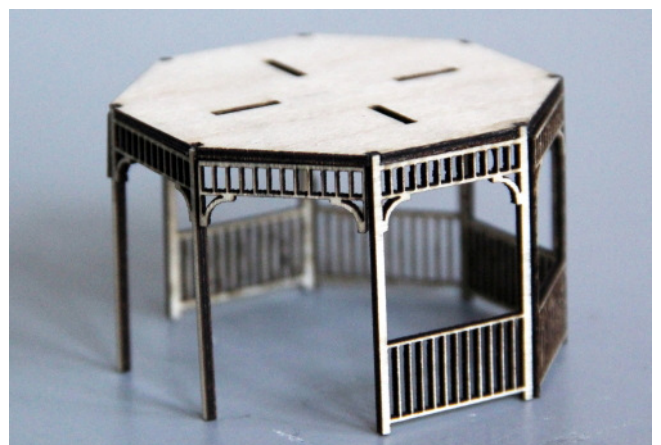
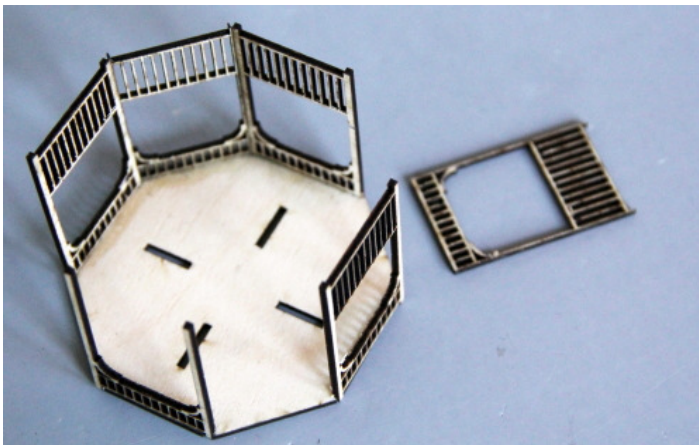
Self-adhesive shingles

Push out all the “fillings” in the railings and trim. Use a pair of tweezers or a small screwdriver.

## Assembly



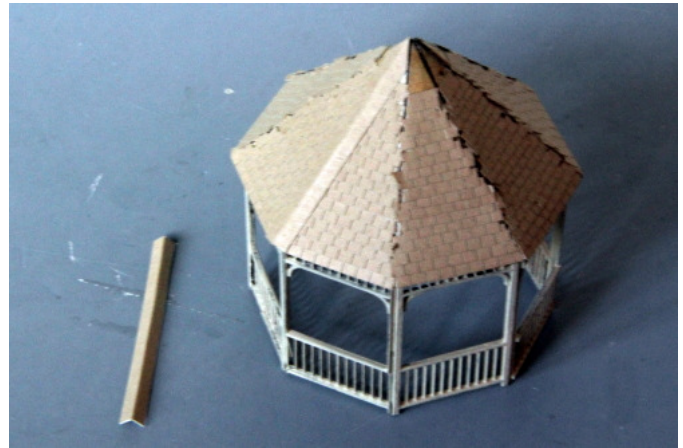
Glue the side pieces with notches on top to the ceiling piece, as shown.



Glue the remaining pieces on.



Glue the roof supports onto the ceiling, then mount the roof pieces.



Mount the shingles on the roof as shown. When all the shingles are in place, mount the flashings. Before mounting the flashing, bend them 90 degrees using a steel ruler. This will prevent the adhesive from loosening.



Paint the wood a cream color, (or whatever color will work for you). Then paint the shingles gray. I used grimy black, but any shade of gray will work fine.
